Under this agreement for 2018
Greenslopes State School will receive

\$122,735*

This funding will be used to:

- increase the number of students achieving above the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Year 3 to 100% in Reading
- increase the number of students achieving above the NMS in Year 5 to 100% in Reading
- increase the number of Year 3 students achieving in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) to 65% in Reading
- increase the number of Year 5 students achieving in the U2Bs to 65% in Reading
- increase the percentage of students achieving an 'A' or 'B' in English across the school (*based on 2017 Semester 1 achievement*):

Our initiatives include:

- employing a Speech Therapy Pathologist to ensure all students across Prep – Year 2 to get additional support and to identify students with oral language delay and initiate support for these students
- ensuring all new staff have been trained in the Reading 2 Learn Framework
- purchasing additional suitable reading resources to support Early Readers across Prep and Year 1
- continuing to develop the Guided Reading Framework across the school
- refining and embedding the school's Instructional Framework to support instructional coaching and implementation of Learning Walks
- closely tracking and aligning explicit instruction to the Guides to Making Judgements.



Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Provide funds for additional teaching staff to support students from an EAL/D background.	\$22 217
Provide funds for additional teacher staff to support students requiring learning support.	\$15 484
Provide funds for additional teacher staff to support students in classroom.	\$76 747
Purchase of suitable reading materials to support early readers.	\$ 4 000
Provide release for teachers to undertake coaching and curriculum conversations.	\$ 4 327
Total	\$122 775
